

**BRANDENBURG BIBLIOGRAPHY**

This bibliography was done according to the order in which the information was found, used or sent to me by other researchers of the Brandenburg family. When new information was found it was added to the bibliography.

The main libraries used were my own library, Hayes Presidential Center Library, 1337 Hayes Avenue, Fremont, Ohio (called "Hayes"), the Burr-Artz Library in Frederick, Maryland (called "Burr-Artz") and the Allen County Public Library Genealogy Department, Weber Street, Fort Wayne, Indiana (called "Ft. Wayne"). Many of the books listed can be found in other genealogical, state and local libraries.

Those books and documents, in which nothing was found, were marked "**Nothing found.**" "OGS" stands for the Ohio Genealogical Society. "mss" stands for manuscript. When using a few books, the publishing information was not documented. Those books are marked "no information."

One branch of the Brandenburg family in Ohio (and beyond) changed the spelling of the surname to "Brandeberry" and another in Georgia to "Blandenburg."
